

Step-by-step instructions on How to access the FSA practice tests

- Access the internet on your computer
- Go to www.fsassessments.org
- Click on the fourth box on the left where it says “Students and Parents”
- Click on “Student and Parent Resource Box” to find information on Florida Student Assessments (FSA), FSA test schedules, charts, on-line testing, math policies and materials, sample Scientific and Graphing Calculators and training test user guide.
- Click on “Training Tests.”
- Click on “Take the Computer-Based Training Test” to actually take the sample tests.
 - When you click on the “Training Tests”, a sign in screen comes up.
 - Click on “Sign In”.
 - Select a grade level on the “Is This You?” page and then click yes.
 - Now you can choose from a variety of tests:

If you chose 5th grade level you will see:

- Start Grades 4-5 FSA ELA Writing
 - Start Grades 3-5 FSA ELA Reading, Writing, & Listening
 - Start Grades 5-6 FSA Mathematics
- Start Infrastructure Trial Test (not this one)*

If you chose 6th grade level you will see:

- Start Grades 6-8 FSA ELA Writing
 - Start Grades 6-8 FSA ELA Reading, Writing, & Listening
 - Start Grades 5-6 FSA Mathematics
 - Start EOC Mathematics
- Start Infrastructure Trial Test (not this one)*

If you chose 7th or 8th grade as the level, you will see:

- Start Grades 6-8 FSA ELA Writing
 - Start Grades 6-8 FSA ELA Reading, Writing, & Listening
 - Start Grades 7-8 FSA Mathematics
 - Start FSA EOC Mathematics
- Start Infrastructure Trial Test (not this one)*

- Choose one of the tests and click on that box.
- Now you can decide on the background and color, and the size. Then click on “Select”.
- “Is This Your Test?” screen will come up and you will select yes, Start My Test.
- Test Instructions and help will come up and then you can select “Begin the test now”.
- Go back to Training Tests start screen to access answer keys
